Our students will have the opportunity for supervised practice in the school's full-service cosmetology clinic.

For Pennsylvania students, you must complete 1,250 hours of instruction and have successful course completion to graduate.

For West Virginia students, you must complete 1,835 hours of instruction and have successful course completion to graduate. Potential WV Cosmetology students must also be approved for a permit through the WV Board of Barbers and Cosmetologists before they are able to fully enroll in the program.
