Does your career need a shot in the arm?

As a phlebotomy technician, you are an important member of the clinical laboratory team. You will gain a lot of experience in your 10 weeks at school. During your program, you will be shown how to draw blood, known as a "stick." You will practice your sticking skills in the classroom on faculty, staff and fellow students so you are prepared and confident before you begin your clinical rotation. The student will also be familiar in the use of the correct terminology regarding capillary puncture, venipuncture, safety, and vacutainer blood collection.

Upon successful completion of the program, which includes 75 classroom and lab hours and a minimum of 100 clinical hours, the student will be issued a certificate and be eligible for employment in the state of Pennsylvania or West Virginia.

Graduates of this program will earn a certificate.
